1. Selection of Head Coach

Head Coaches

- **1.1** Based upon the recommendations of the Coach Selection / Rep Committee, all decisions regarding the selection of Head Coaches shall be made by the BMHA Board are final. The Coach Selection Committee will consist of the following members: Director of Rep, Rep Conveners and participants recommended by the Rep Committee and chaired by the Director of Rep. The Director of Rep will vote only to break tie votes.
- 1.2 Applications for Head Coach positions will be made available in January. Only one Coach level and division preference per application will be accepted. Coach application forms will be available online at www.barrieminorhockey.net. Completed applications must be submitted in accordance with the date and timelines posted on the website. No applications will be accepted after the deadline unless indicated on the website.
- **1.3** The Coach Selection Committee shall conduct all interviews for Head Coach positions. Other than in exceptional circumstances, no less than 3 members from the Coach Selection Committee will be present for any interview. Given the volume of applications and time constraints, applications will be reviewed and prioritized for interviews.
- **1.4** Prior to making any Head Coach recommendations, the Coach Selection Committee will seek input from Conveners and the Director of Rep.
- 1.5 All Head Coach positions will be selected on an annual basis. The Coach Selection Committee will consider an existing coach (returning head coach) application based on their most recent year completed under BMHA and team compliance with BMHA policies, rostered bench staff suspensions, player development needs and capabilities and qualifications of the individual Head Coach applicant. The Coach Selection Committee and the Director of Rep may opt to extend a coach's tenure at any category and division during the current hockey season and prior to Coach Selection process, pending BMHA board approval of the candidate. Subject to review on an annual basis as per aforementioned guideline section 3.3
- 1.6 The Coach Selection Committee will consider all applications submitted. Under circumstances where there are no submissions for a team, or the Committee deems there are no suitable candidates for a particular Division and Category, the Coach Selection Committee has the flexibility to select and hold discussions with applicants about taking a team they did not indicate in their application and/or recruit candidates beyond the application submission deadline.

1.7 It is the policy of the Association to favour suitable and qualified applicants for Head Coach positions who do not have a child, or relative, playing on the team. If an applicant has a child or potential relative trying out for the team, the skill level of the child or, potential relative, will be a factor considered when determining whether the applicant should be selected as a Head Coach and/or selected/denied for a Coach interview.

2. Coach Movement

2.1 If an existing BMHA Head Coach moves up a Category level (i.e. from AE to A, from A to AA) to a Head Coach role in the same age group the next season, and the Head Coach has a child or relative on the team, then a Player Selection Panel would automatically be put in place by the Director of Rep to oversee the team tryouts and to assist with the selection of the team. Prior to this, the Player Selection Panel will scout and confirm the child or relative has the appropriate skill set to compete at the higher level.

3. Head Coach Selection Process

- 3.1 All persons interested in applying for a BMHA team, will complete a Coach application found on the website. These applications will be submitted to the Barrie Minor Hockey Office in a sealed envelope and dropped in the Coach Application box to the attention of the Director of Rep. All applications are considered to be classified as confidential until selected for a Coach interview. At that time the applicant's name must be exposed to that category and division's Coach Selection Committee. BMHA understands the sensitivity and confidentiality of each application and will protect the applicant's name from the public, BMHA staff, BMHA executive and the BMHA Rep Committee Members. Only completed applications will be considered for review. No emailed applications will be received and/or accepted by BMHA staff, Executive Members or Rep Committee members. No exceptions.
- **3.2** The Director of Rep will review all Coach applications for each age category and level. Consideration will be given to coaches who are applying to return and who are considered to be a 'Coach in Good Standing'. The Director of Rep and Rep Committee will consider the following when determining 'good standing':
- Team or staff issues during previous season
- Success and development of the team and players he/she is currently coaching
- Commitment to the organization as shown by attendance at coach development sessions, adhering to team volunteer hours and attending organization events
- Conduct during team events such as games, practices and tournaments
- Tenure as a head coach

Although there is no set time limit or number of years for the tenure of a head coach, consideration will be given to the previous years that the applicant has coached the same team and the impact on the overall development of a team. In essence, a coach may coach more than two years but is not guaranteed more than one

- Commitment to continued coach development courses and certifications
- 3.3 After the Director of Rep opens each Coach application and reviews each in confidence, he or she will make a recommendation (or not) to the Rep Committee that an existing Head Coach be considered for another year as a BMHA Head Coach at the next division level at the equivalent category. The decision to request the Rep Committee's approval for each application is solely the responsibility of the Director of Rep. All competing Head Coach applications at that division, level and category would only be exposed to the Rep Committee if the Director of Rep's request for preliminary Coach approval of a returning Coach is denied by the Rep Committee. A minimum of five Rep Committee members (quorum?) must be in attendance at this meeting to vote. The Director of Rep is not permitted to vote. All ties are broken by the President of BMHA. If the Director of Rep's request is approved, and voted majority yes, the coach will automatically be recommended to the BMHA executive as next year's selected Head Coach for that level, division and category. The individual will be advised of the Board's position, once approved, and the position will be posted to the members/public prior to the end of the hockey season. All competing applicants, at this level, will be advised of the Rep Committee position.
- 3.4 If the Rep Committee denies the Director of Rep's request for approval and votes a majority (NO) for that individual's head coach position for another year, the individual (applicant) is granted an interview and shall compete will all the other submitted applicants that have been approved and granted an interview at his or her level.
- **3.5** The following will be used as criteria for coach interviews based on multiple applicants at one single level, division and category:
- * Is the person a parent or non-parent applicant
- * If a parent, what level did the applicant's child play in the current year. The player will be evaluated to determine the skill level of play and if that level is suitable for the level being applied for.
- * Coaching experienced based on hockey related coaching and education
- * Experience within BMHA. Has the applicant been involved in any capacity in the past with the Barrie Minor Hockey Association or another hockey association?
- 3.6 The Coach Selection Committee will interview only candidates that are deemed suitable by the Rep Committee. A set group of questions will be used for all candidates to assist the Selection Committee in a fair evaluation of the applicants. The Selection

Committee will advise the Rep Committee of their recommendations for Head Coach positions.

- **3.7** The Rep Committee will make recommendations to the Director of Rep for all Head Coach positions.
- **3.8** The Director of Rep on behalf of the Rep Committee will make recommendations to the BMHA Board for all Head Coach Rep positions. The Board will approve and announce all Head Coach positions.
