

BMHA Tryout Process for 2021/2022 Season

☐ Non Resident Player (NRP) Tryout Evaluations (AA Only)¹

□ M. Pee Wee (U12), Pee Wee (U13), M. Bantam (U14), Bantam (U15) and M Midget (U16); skill evaluation

Note: All NRP's must attend the skill evaluation skate including incumbent BMHA NRP and new NRP's. All exceptions must be approved by Director of Rep Jr, (M Pee Wee) and Sr. (Pee Wee to Minor Midget). All NRP's are required to be registered with an approved <u>Home Centre</u> (Non Resident) Passport.

☐ HL and New Player Identification Skate, this applies to the U11-U16 Age groups.

☐ Open to current BMHA HL players & new resident players to the BMHA, residing within the BMHA boundaries for representative hockey.

²Result: An invite to "AA" "A" (White &/or Blue)" or AE/MD camp or released back to BMHA HL

Note: Minor Peewee (U12)); an invite of a maximum of 22 players plus 4 goalies (total 26) will be offered to attend Minor Pee Wee "A" White and Blue camp or an invite to attend the Minor Pee Wee AE camp only. It is the discretion of each 'A" White and Blue Coach to communicate the invite to attend the "A" tryout. The "AE" coach can invite players directly to the "AE" first tryout if not offered an 'A" tryout. You are required to be invited from the evaluation skate by a coach to attend "A" white and Blue or "AE" tryout. The coach will email you within 24 hours after evaluation skate.

No "HL and New Player Identification Skate" BMHA refund or credits will be issued if released back to HL. This may result in one skate for the tryout registration fee, NO EXCEPTIONS.

¹ Note a maximum of 5 NRP players per division will be invited/allowed to attend AA tryouts.

² Note each division "AA", "A" or "AE/MD" coach will issue the invitation to attend via email after the identification skate after confirming their selection with each division/level coach.



☐ Alternate Entry (AE/MD) Camp (The first AE/MD Divisional tryout skate see schedule)

- 2 skate per division
- Please be advised that this tryout skate might be split ice sessions based on tryout enrollment numbers.
- Invites are limited to all current "AE/MD" team members and Rostered Select from the 2019/2020 season and any coach invited players from the HL and new Player Identification skate. <u>Optional for A Blue players.</u>

Note: Players that have been invited to attend "AA" or "A" camp from the identification skate by the respective coach do not report to the 'MD" camp, they report to their respective invited level "AA" or "A". From this invited starting point of tryouts, they would continue the process of attending one level lower after being released.

Note: Returning 2019/2020"AE/MD" players may be invited to attend "AA" camp after this tryout.

AA Camp (The following information applies to the U11-U18 age groups)

- Invites are limited to current 2019/2020 "AA", "A White" and any coach invited players.
- A maximum of five NRPs that have been selected by each coach from the NRP evaluation skate (if applicable). All exceptions must be approved by Director of REP.

Note: No releases shall occur until after the 2^{nd} tryout, all released players except NRP's report to the A White camp.

☐ A White Camp

 Invites are limited to 2019/2020 "A" White and Blue & any players released from the AA tryout as well as any coach invited players. NRP's are not eligible.

 Please be advised that this tryout skate might be split ice sessions based on player enrollment and invitation numbers.

Note: No releases shall occur until after the 2nd tryout. All players released report to "A Blue" camp.

Note: At the <u>Minor Pee Wee(U12) level ONLY</u> a coach can offer a player an OMHA commitment letter at "A" white and "A" blue after the second tryout with the agreement of the "A" white coach. This will permit additional open ice for coach selection and player competition at the "A" white and blue level. The player signing an early commitment letter may not participate on-ice at the remaining tryouts.

☐ A Blue Camp

☐ Invites are limited to 2019/2020 "A" Blue and AE/MD players and all previous tryout releases from the "AA" and "A" White tryout process. Coach invited players from previous HL and AE/MD skates.

Note: No releases shall occur until after the 2nd tryout.

. All players released report to AE/MD

☐ AE/MD Camp

☐ Invites are limited to 2019/2020 AE/MD players and all previous tryout releases from the "AA" and "A" tryout process. Coach invited players from previous HL skate.

Note: Players may be released after the first tryout. All players released can register for House League as per the normal registration process.

<u>U9:</u>

➤ All players that have registered for Rep Tryouts in these age groups will report directly to the AA tryouts, your child will attend a total of 4 tryouts and at that time the AA coach will pick his team followed by the A coach picking there team. All remaining players not chosen for 1 of these teams will report to the Houseleague grouping.



U10:

➤ Same format as above with the exception of 3 Rep teams being chosen, AA, A, AE. All remaining players not chosen for 1 of these teams will report to the Houseleague grouping.

Declaration forms have been discontinued. In the event of an extreme circumstance only, please contact the Rep Director of your division. Players must play on the team, division level where they are offered a letter of commitment. If the letter of commitment is refused, the player will only be released to register for House League.
