

## **Policy #: 201416**

### **Section: Financial** **Subject: Outstanding Fees**

Any member of BMHA that has outstanding fees from the previous hockey season, owing to BMHA that player and/or family will be considered as members not in good standing. As such, the player's registration will not be expected for the current hockey season until the full outstanding balance has been paid. Should the player have registered online, they will be advised in writing by email of the outstanding amount and will be provided with 7 business days to either satisfy the amount owing or make suitable arrangements to pay the amount owing.

Failure to make suitable arrangements will result in the registration fees being reversed, minus a \$50 administration fee. Failure to meet the arrangement will result in the immediate de-registration of the player and BMHA will refund any fee paid minus a \$50 administration fee.

Any player that has outstanding fees to BMHA will not be eligible to obtain a Permission to Skate form for residential AAA zone until such time as the amount owing has been paid in full.

Any player that is new to BMHA and from another OMHA Centre and providing that the OMHA Centre has advised BMHA in writing that there are fees outstanding from the previous season. BMHA will not allow that player/family to register in BMHA until BMHA receives written confirmation that the outstanding amount has been paid in full from the OMHA Centre that the funds are owing to.
